Several single JDs can be combined into **part- or full time internship positions** for which we offer a negotiable compensation based on candidate's skills and competencies. We generally recommend to start with a volunteer role to learn about our workflow and move from there gradually towards more responsibilities.

We expect from all candidates an **affection for nature**, a **growth mindset and digital literacy**, but offer training on the job in regard to all tasks. Use this opportunity to improve your own skill set in a team of purpose driven educators.

a) Responsibility:

Guide event participants in an enjoyable way through our itineraries and re-connect them with self, others and planet.

b) Tasks:

1. Prepare event location and required infrastructure
2. Manage check-in and event onboarding
3. Guide participants through activity and ensure safety
4. Engage with customers and anticipate their needs during event
5. Compose and share post-event information with team and participants

c) Skills & competencies:

1. Interest in education and ecology
2. Nature guide experience of advantage
3. Successful participation in Green Steps facilitator training
4. High proficiency in written and spoken English
5. Chinese proficiency of advantage
6. Natural interest in customer well-being

d) Time commitment:

20 hours/month to full time; minimum 3 months
